Andrew 'Bart' Simpson was an Olympic Gold and Silver medallist who tragically passed away in 2013. Andrew passionately believed that everyone should have the opportunity to experience sailing and watersports, regardless of their background or circumstances.

The first Bart's Bash took place in 2014. Thousands of people from around the world came together to race in memory of Bart. The event was such a success it was awarded a Guinness World Record for the world's largest sailing race.

This year marks the 12th annual Bart's Bash Race. The event continues to connect the global sailing community, create opportunities for people to get on the water and raise essential funds for the ASF. With your help, Bart's Bash will continue to be a global event, enabling people to get out on the water and keeping Bart's name alive for generations to come.

### HOW TO TAKE PART IN BART'S BASH 2025

#### Register your venue

Each venue will be able to register online here to receive the latest event updates, connect with your wider sailing community and customise your fundraising and race page.

#### Officers and safety crew

Ensure there is the usual team of race officers and safety crew, fully briefed on race requirements prior to the day.

#### Involve the local community

Use this opportunity to involve your wider local community by encouraging sign up from individuals who would not ordinarily actively participate in sailing.

#### Tell everyone!

Make the most of your local press and shout about your clubs involvement as much as you can to encourage your community to come sailing!

#### Nominate your event organiser

This person is going to be the main point of contact between your venue and the Bart's Bash team for all notifications and information.

#### **Use ASF resources**

Use Bart's Bash resources to help you run your event and encourage your entire membership to participate in this global race.

#### **Gather your participants**

Encourage all of your club members to take part in this global race and be ranked amongst the world's finest sailors!

#### Send us your results

Send us all your results and supporting documents, including photos from the event within 10 days of the race.

## RUNNING YOUR EVENT AND SUBMITTING RESULTS

Here are a few tips from our Bart's Bash event organisers on how to run your race.

#### MAKE A DAY OF IT

Incorporate your race into your Sunday racing or plan a whole day event to remember Bart.

#### **FORGET WEATHER WOES**

If tidal conditions look to effect your race, you can request a 7 day extension by emailing us at Bart's Bash.

#### **BE INCLUSIVE**

Make your race a mixed class fleet to encourage more sailors of all abilities.

#### **SHARE FACILITIES**

Use this opportunity to encourage your local community to experience getting on the water and your club facilities.

#### INVOLVE THE COMMUNITY

Ask your members to host individuals from the community on their boats to give them a taste of sailing before the race!

#### **PROMOTE YOUR CLUB**

You could even set up a membership sign up stall to encourage new members to join!

### SUBMITTING YOUR RESULTS IS SMOOTH SAILING

We have created an online platform for sailing clubs, centres and groups to enter the world's largest sailing race where every sailor, from grassroots to the greatest, can take part in a race at their local venue on the same date, all gaining a result in this inclusive event.

#### PREPARE YOUR RACE DETAILS

Get your length of your course in metres, number of laps, time elapsed for each Sailor, plus wind strength details ready, ahead of submitting your results online.

#### **EASILY ADD NEW SAILORS**

You can upload an excel spreadsheet of sailors if they haven't signed up using the website.

#### SMART ONLINE RANKINGS

Your position in the race is worked out on our Bart's calculation, and this takes into account Portsmouth Yardstick (dinghies) or IRC/ORC (yachts).

#### **SAILWAVE SUPPORT**

You can also directly upload a Sailwave file of your results, if required.
